

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS THIS A FREE DOWNLOAD SITE?

Well, almost. Even if this is not a profit-oriented site, please understand, that I can't offer such a huge download site completely for free. I need to share at least part of the costs for traffic and hosting with the members.

I offer a 1-year-membership for a very tiny fee. After the year is over you'll be automatically removed from the Gallery. No follow-up costs, no automatic renewal of your membership (except if you want to).

HOW CAN I PURCHASE A MEMBERSHIP?

The links are provided on the main site of the gallery. You'll be re-directed to a site where you can find a short explanation about the membership and also the PayPal button.

HOW WILL I GET ACCESS TO THE GALLERY AFTER BUYING A MEMBERSHIP?

After making your payment you'll be brought back to the main page of the gallery. Now it's about time to **register yourself as a new user!** As soon as I receive the notification from PayPal about the payment your account will be opened. An extra welcome mail will be sent to you.

Notice: Without your registration the payment can't be assigned to your person and your account stays closed.

HOW CAN I DOWNLOAD MY FAVORITE FILES?

Once your account is open, log in and browse the categories. Simply click on any image you like and you'll get a larger view of the design. Below the image is the download button. This is how it works with member files.

If you're about to download a **FREEBIE** (extra category) you'll find a **4shared-link** within the description of the design (below preview).

I WANT TO RATE DESIGNS - HOW DO THE NUMBERS RATE?

5 = excellent / 1 = bad

WHAT FILE FORMATS DO YOU PROVIDE?

99% of the designs in the low-res. category (72ppi) are in Paint Shop Pro's PSP-format.

But all high-res. designs (300ppi) are in **PNG-format**. In future there'll be only PNG-format files uploaded to my Gallery.

WORKING WITH ADOBE PHOTOSHOP - CAN I USE PSP-FILES TOO?

Belief it or not - you can! There is a small plug-in available what gives Photoshop users the possibility to import PSP-layers. All about this little plug-in and how it works can be found here:
